Tuesday November 17th - Mayoral Run-off Election

Time to return to the polls to vote for your candidate in the run off for Mayor. Please make sure that you, your family, and neighbors cast their votes.

Absentee ballot request forms can be picked up at the Supervisor of Elections office located at 240 So. Military Trail West Palm Beach, FL 33425. Forms can also be obtain on line at www.pbcelections.com by clicking on Absentee Ballot on the scroll down menu located on the left side of the home page. Absentee Ballot requests must be filed no later than the Wednesday before the election, 11/11. Actual absentee ballots will be mailed to the voter at the address indicated on the form or can be picked up at the Supervisor of Elections office. The completed ballot must be received and in hand at the main office (address above) of the Supervisor of Elections no later than 7:00 pm on election night. Please note the Supervisor of Elections Office closes at 5 pm on election night. You can request absentee ballots for any of your immediate family members and up to two non related voters.
