PRESIDENT'S CORNER

The office of the Mayor and several city commissioners will be on the November 3rd General Election ballot. Among the important issues the city is facing this year is the approved reverse osmosis water plant and its impact on our escalating water bills and the escalating rates the city charges for power. Pleas note these two important dates on your calendar.

Tuesday October 27th

The College Park and Parrot Cove home owners association will be hosting a candidates forum. All of the candidates have been invited to attend. The forum will be held on October 27th at St. Andrews Church, 100 North Palmway (on the corner of Lucerne) at 7:00 pm.

College Park residents will be voting for a new Mayor as well as two city commissioners. Wes Blackman and Jo-Ann Golden are running for commissioner of District 3. Scott Maxwell and Ron Exline are running for commissioner of District 1. The six mayoral candidates include William Coakley, Javier del Sol, John Jordan, Laurence McNamara, Loretta Sharpe and Rene Varella. Each candidate will speak for 5 minutes followed by a Q & A session where the candidates will respond to written questions.

For your information, on October 25th the Neighborhood Association President's Council will be holding a city wide candidates forum at the Lake Worth Playhouse at 7 pm.

Tuesday November 10th

Many of your neighbors have been discussing the escalating utility costs and the city's sliding scale rates for electricity, water, and sewage. The College Park and Parrot Cove neighborhood associations have asked the City Manager, Susan Stanton, and Utility Director, Rebecca Mattey, to address our concerns and answer questions regarding this issue. This meeting will also be held at St Andrews Church, 100 North Palmway (on the corner of Lucerne) at 7:00 pm.
